**Archbishop Bernard Longley** has commissioned a review of the current safeguarding/child protection practices within the Archdiocese in light of the National Catholic Policies and Procedures. This review will ensure that our systems to protect children and young people are as effective as possible. It is being conducted by an independent charity called SCIE (Social Care Institute for Excellence). SCIE would like to speak with any individuals who have had experience with any safeguarding issues within the Archdiocese — parish safeguarding representatives and the safeguarding team at the Archdiocese.
